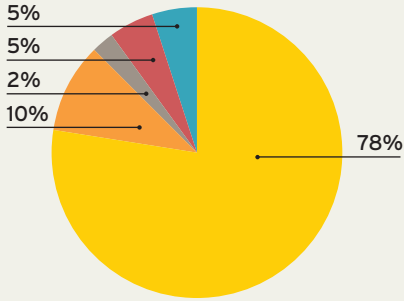

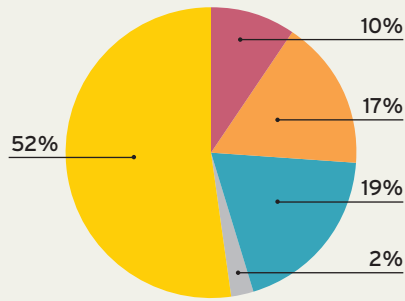

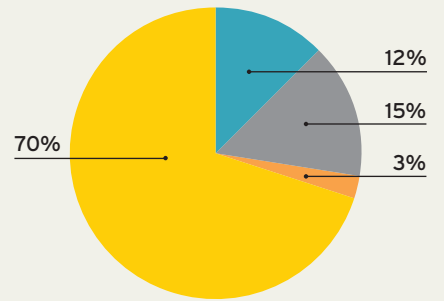

Ethnicity



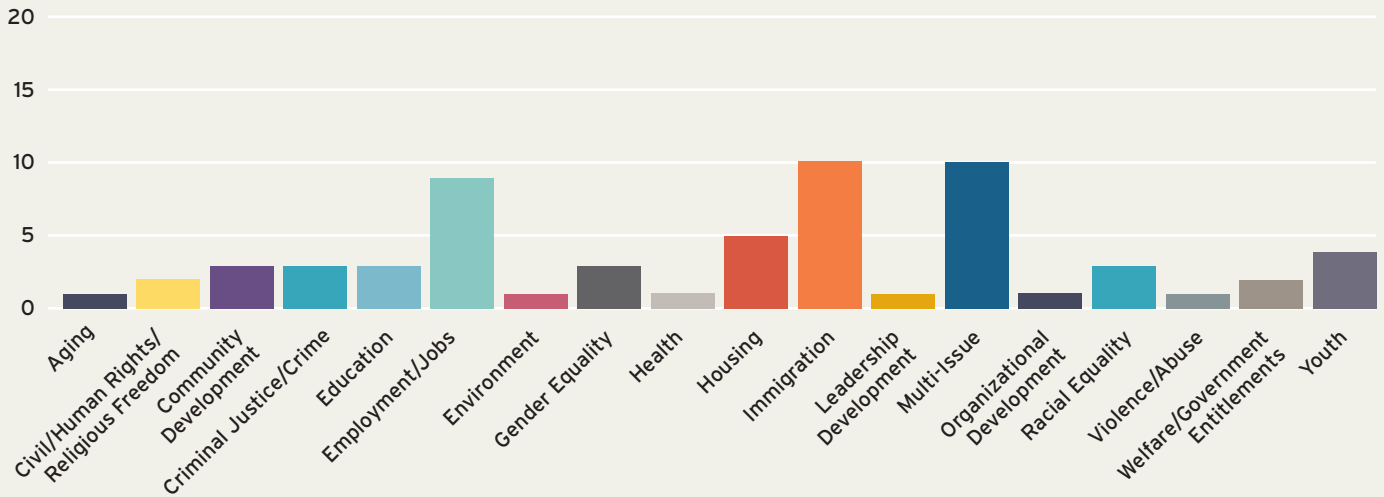

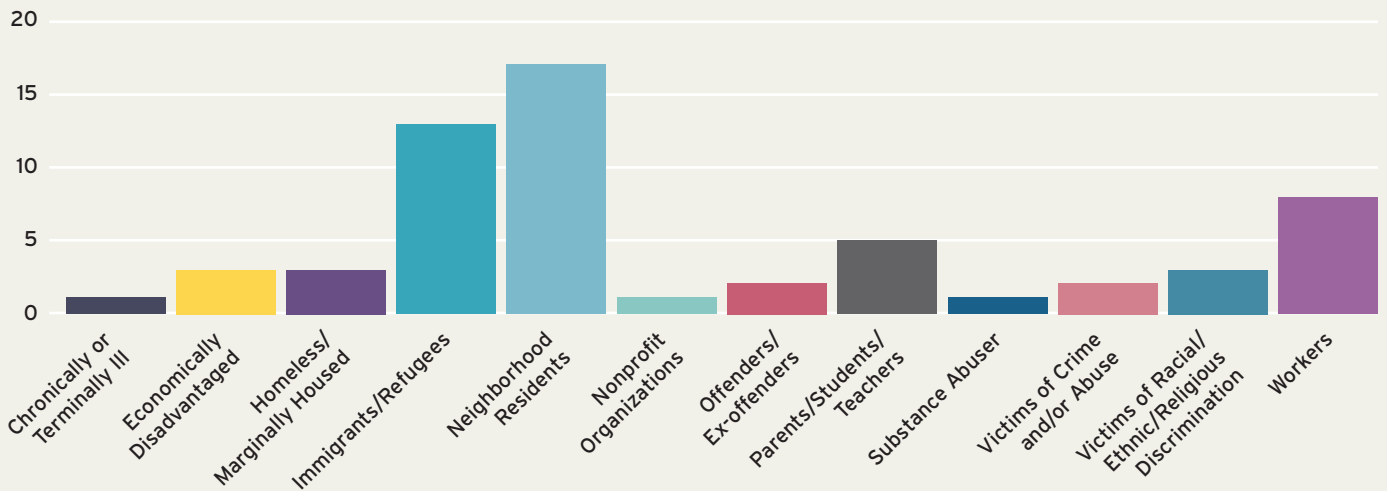

Focus of Work Supported

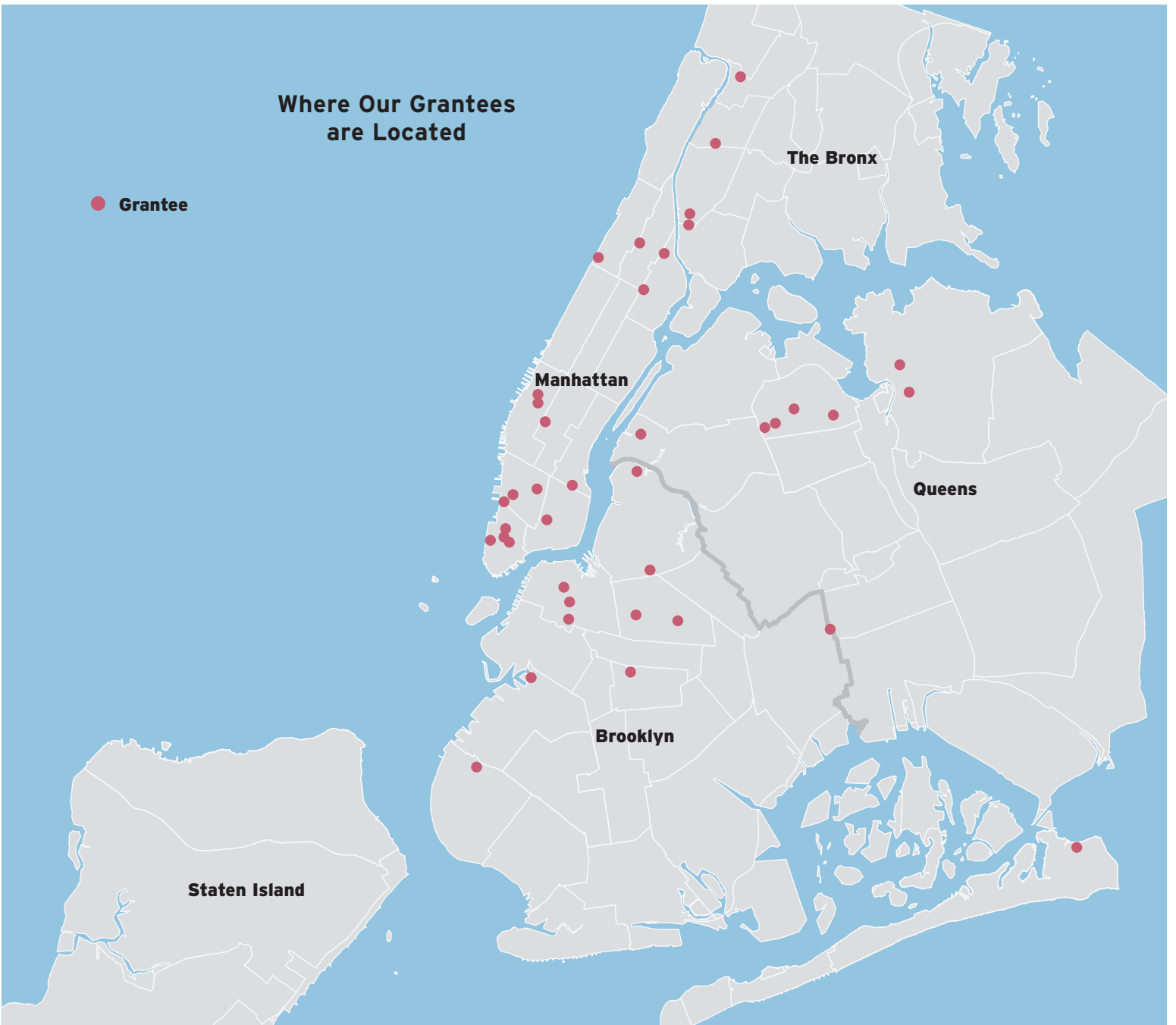


Population Served
