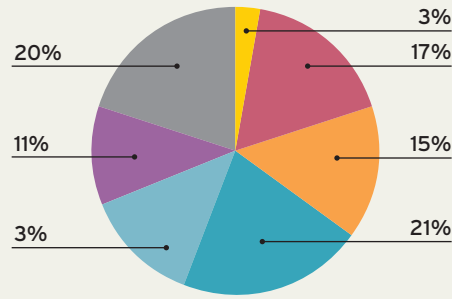

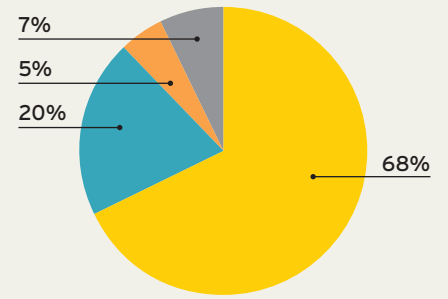

Ethnicity



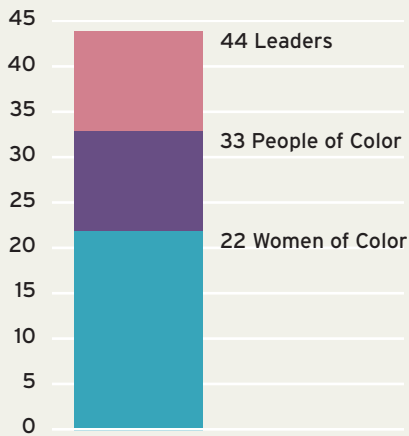

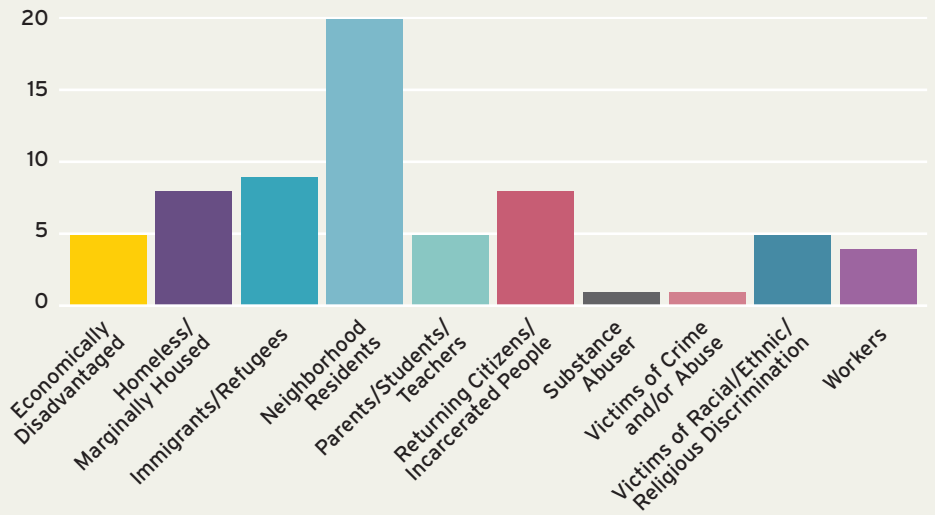

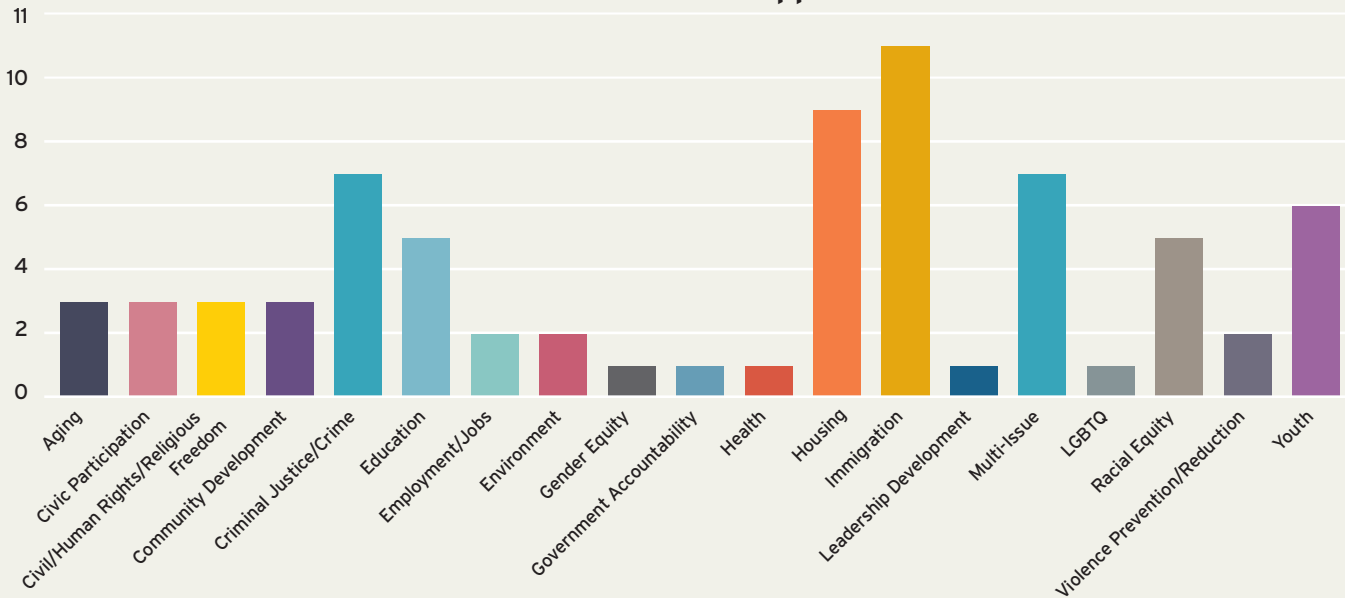
